About the Rosary?

October is traditionally known as the month of the Rosary, mainly because the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated in the Church's calendar on the 7^{th} October.

The Rosary is possibly the best loved and most widely used of our Catholic prayers. It has been a cherished part of the prayer life of millions of people for many centuries. I am often inspired by stories of numerous people with a deep love for the Rosary who have experienced it as a powerful and consoling form of prayer.

Pope St John Paul II, who had a great love for the Rosary himself, once said, "To recite the Rosary is nothing other than to contemplate, with Mary, the face of Christ." There are different ways of praying the Rosary: one can meditate on the 'mysteries' of Jesus' life while using the prayers as a kind of mantra; or one might pay attention to the actual words of the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be; or we might simply hold in our thoughts a particular intention we wish to pray for at that time. The Rosary also contains a deep connection with our Mother Mary, and her companionship can be a great comfort.

If you'd like to discover the power and comfort of the Rosary but don't know how to pray it, feel free to ask me or any parishioner who prays it regularly.
